
This letter is to state the following:

We, the undersigned, in a special restraining order of the High Rabbinical Court upon listening to the argument and reading all affidavits between Rabbi David Schick and Rabbi Hersch M. Ginsberg resulting in the dispute between Copyworld Printing Inc. and Simcha Printing Inc. Index No. 11070/90 have issued the following order:


- 1.) We have found based on sufficient facts and evidence that there had been serious contradictions and disagreements between the arbitrators and no true final decision is agreed upon on the dispute between Copyworld Printing Inc. and Simcha Printing Inc. based on the Halacha (Code of Jewish Law).
- 2.) The confidential memorandum or "Psak" signed by the arbitrators on January 1st, 1992 is therefore incomplete and simply invalid and should not be used in any way.
- 3.) We therefore advised Rabbi David Schick only to direct Chaim Wassertheil upon his understanding how to presume his claim to solve this matter.
- 4.) Rabbi Hersch M. Ginsberg is requested to consult the Beth Din at once if he should have any objection to our restraining order and to arrange for a hearing before a full panel of our rabbinical court.
- 5.) The restraining order is in effect until future notice of our higher court.
