### SHACHRIS

Yaaleh Veyavo and Al Hanisim in weekday *Shemonah Esrei*; *Chazzan's* Repetition; complete *Hallel*; *Kaddish Tiskabel*. We take out two *Sifrei Torah*; in the first we have three *Aliyahs* in *Parshas Pinchas* in the regular *Torah Reading for Rosh Chodesh* (Numbers 28:1-15): *Kohen* reads from *Vayedaber* until *Raviis Hahini*; *Levi* reads from the following verse until *Vaniscah*; *Yisroel* continues until *Vanisco* the fourth *Aliyah* is in the second *Sefer Torah* in *Parshas Naso* (Numbers 7:48-53) *Bayom Hashvii*; Half - *Kaddish*; *Yehalilu* the *Torah* is returned to the *Aron HaKodesh*; *Ashrei*; *Uva Letzion* (no *Lamnazeach*); Half-*Kaddish*.

### MUSSAF

We remove our *Tefillin*; *Shemonah Esrei* of *Mussaf* for *Rosh Chodesh* with *Al Hanisim*; *Chazzan's*

Repetition; *Kaddish Tiskabel*; Aleinu; Psalm of the Day; *Borch Nafshi*; *Mizmor Shir Chanukas*; Mourner's *Kaddish*.

## **EIGHTH DAY CHANUKAH**

MONDAY, JAN. 2, 2 TEVES

### **SHACHRIS**

*Shemonah Esrei with Al Hanisim*; *Chazzan's Repetition*; complete *Hallel*; Half-*Kaddish*; Torah Reading: three *Aliyahs* in *Parshas Naso* and concluding in *Parshas B'haalosecha* (Numbers 7:54-8:4); *Kohen* reads (54-56) from *Bayom Hashmini* until "*Meleah Ketores*"; *Levi* reads (57-59) until *Gamliel ben Pedalzur*; *Yisroel* reads (7:60-8:4) from *Bayom Hatshii* until *Kein Asah Es Hamenorah* in *Parshas B'haalosecha*; Half-*Kaddish*; *Yehalilu*; *Ashrei*; *Uva Letzion*; (no *Lamnazeach*); *Kaddish Tiskabel*; Aleinu; Psalm of the Day; *Mizmor Shir Chanukas*; Mourner's *Kaddish*.

## **SHABBOS PARSHAS VAYIGASH**

JAN. 7, 7 TEVES

The *Haftorah* is read from Ezekiel 37:15-28.

### **FAST OF TENTH OF TEVES**

TUESDAY, JAN. 10, 10 TEVES

Public Fast Day.

### **SHACHRIS**

Half-*Kaddish*; we take out a *Sefer Torah* and read *Vayichal* as in the morning. No Half-*Kaddish* after the Torah is read; the third *Aliyah* is the *Maftir*. The *Haftorah "Dirshu"* Isaiah: 55:6-56:8 (until *Akabetz Aluv Lanikbazav*) is the usual one for the afternoons of Public Fasts; *Brachos* after the *Haftorah* until *Mogen David*; *Yehalilu*; Half-*Kaddish*; *Shemonah Esrei* including *Aneinu* in *Shema Koleinu*; *Sim Shalom*. During the *Chazzan's Repetition*, the *Chazzan* says *Aneinu* between *Goel* and *Rafaenu*; *Birkas Kohanim* before *Sim Shalom*. *Avinu Malkenu*; *Tachanun*; *Kaddish Tiskabel*; Aleinu; Mourner's *Kaddish*.

The final time for the sanctification of the New Moon of *Teves* is *Motzei Shabbos* Jan. 14. until 7:22 PM (15 Teves).

## **SHABBOS PARSHAS VAYECHI**

JAN. 14, 14 TEVES

The *Haftorah* is read from Kings I 2:1-12.

THURSDAY, JAN. 19, 19 TEVES

(Some begin a series of six fast days, each occurring on the Thursday preceding the next six weekly *Parshas* [whose first letters form the acronym *Shovovim*].)

## **SHABBOS PARSHAS SHEMOS**

JAN. 21, 21 TEVES

The *Haftorah* is read from Isaiah 27:6-28:13 then skipping to 29:22-23.

## **SHABBOS PARSHAS VAEIRA**

JAN. 28, 28 TEVES

The *Haftorah* is read from Ezekiel 28:25-29:21. We bless the month of *Shevat*. We do not say "*Av Harachamim*" or *Kayl Malei*. We say "*Tzidkascha Tzedek*" at *Mincha*.

### **EREV ROSH CHODESH**

SUNDAY, JAN. 29, 29 TEVES

(Some observe *Yom Kippur Koton*.) We do not say *Tachanun* at *Mincha*.
