- 1. How can I be sure that the meats or meat products (or for that matter hotels and catering establishments) advertised as "glatt kosher" are indeed prepared according to the strictest interpretations of Halacha (Jewish law)?
- 2. What are the credentials of the supervising agency or supervising rabbi of the glatt products I eat?
- 3. What standards are applied on these "glatt kosher" establishments by the supervising agency or rabbi in certifying the product as glatt kosher?
- 4. Is the proprietor of the "glatt kosher" store, factory, hotel or catering establishment himself an observant Jew, particularly a Shomer Shabbos.

If you have dedicated your life to scrupulously observing the high standards of "glatt kosher" as is dictated by Jewish law and tradition, you owe it to yourself to know the answers to these questions.
