R' Chaim then turned and headed towards the Damascus Gate. A frantic R' Israel grabbed R' Chaim and begged him to use the Jaffa Gate instead, since the Arabs in that section were much les s hostile than the Arabs in the vicinity of the Damascus Gate. "Certainly not!" was R' Chaim's emphatic reply. "I will go specifically via the Damascus Gate and thus inform the Arabs that they have not succeeded in frightening Jews out of even one section of the Holy City."
